- Shower

- Onsite counseling services and intakes
- Onsite case management
- Psychiatric assessments and diagnosis
- Consultation, and treatment is available for those who experiencing homelessness including:
 - Depression
 - Anxiety
 - Psychotic disorders
 - Schizophrenia
 - Bipolar and mood disorders
