

# State of Idaho January 2010 Point-in-Time Count Report

Beginning in 2005 Idaho has conducted an annual Point-in-Time (PIT) Count of the homeless in our state. The data from this count helps determine the amount of funding awarded for Idaho's homeless programs. The following report is the result of Idaho's statewide one-night Point-in-Time Count conducted on January 27, 2010.

The Continuum of Care (CoC) application for McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act funding requires CoC's to produce "statistically reliable, unduplicated counts of homeless persons in sheltered and unsheltered locations at a one-day point in time". In addition, CoC's are required to identify the extent of chronic homelessness within their boundaries by reporting the number of chronically homeless people in shelters and in the unsheltered homeless population, based on local data collected through one-day point in time counts.

For the PIT Count, CoC's are instructed to count all adults, children in households, and unaccompanied youth who meet HUD's definition of homelessness. At the time of the count a person is considered homeless only when he/she resides in one of the places described below at the time of the count:

- Unsheltered homeless person resides in a place not meant for human habitation. Included in this count are people in temporary tents or armory shelters, encampments, and warming centers.
- A sheltered homeless person resides in an emergency shelter, transitional housing or supportive housing for homeless persons who originally came for the streets or emergency shelters.

*This definition of homelessness does not include persons who may be staying with friends or relatives, in a hotel/motel, in a treatment facility or in jail. Persons in these circumstances are defined as "Precariously Housed" and are often characterized as being at imminent risk of becoming homeless.*

## Summary of Survey Results

- 2346 sheltered and unsheltered individuals and persons in households counted as homeless; a 21% increase from 2009
- 1345 single individuals and 332 Households of two or more persons (1001 total persons in households)
- Of persons who identified gender, 59% male and 40% female
- Of persons who identified age, 24% are under the age of 18
- Of persons who identified Disabling Condition, 26% suffer from substance abuse and 14% from Mental Illness
- Of persons who identified, 13% are Veterans and 15% are victims of Domestic Violence
- 335 Precariously Housed individuals or households were surveyed during the unsheltered portion of the count, and although not included in the final count numbers, the survey responses are included in a separate form at the end of this report.

The Point-in-Time Count consists of two methods to collect data for the night of Wednesday, January 27, 2010. The sheltered homeless data is collected from surveys filled out by the shelters and from the Idaho Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) database. The unsheltered homeless survey is administered by "street or known locations" and "service based" counts conducted in each region in the state and entered into HMIS.

- The homeless person must have been sleeping in a place not meant for human habitation (e.g. living on the streets) and/or in emergency shelter at the time of the count.

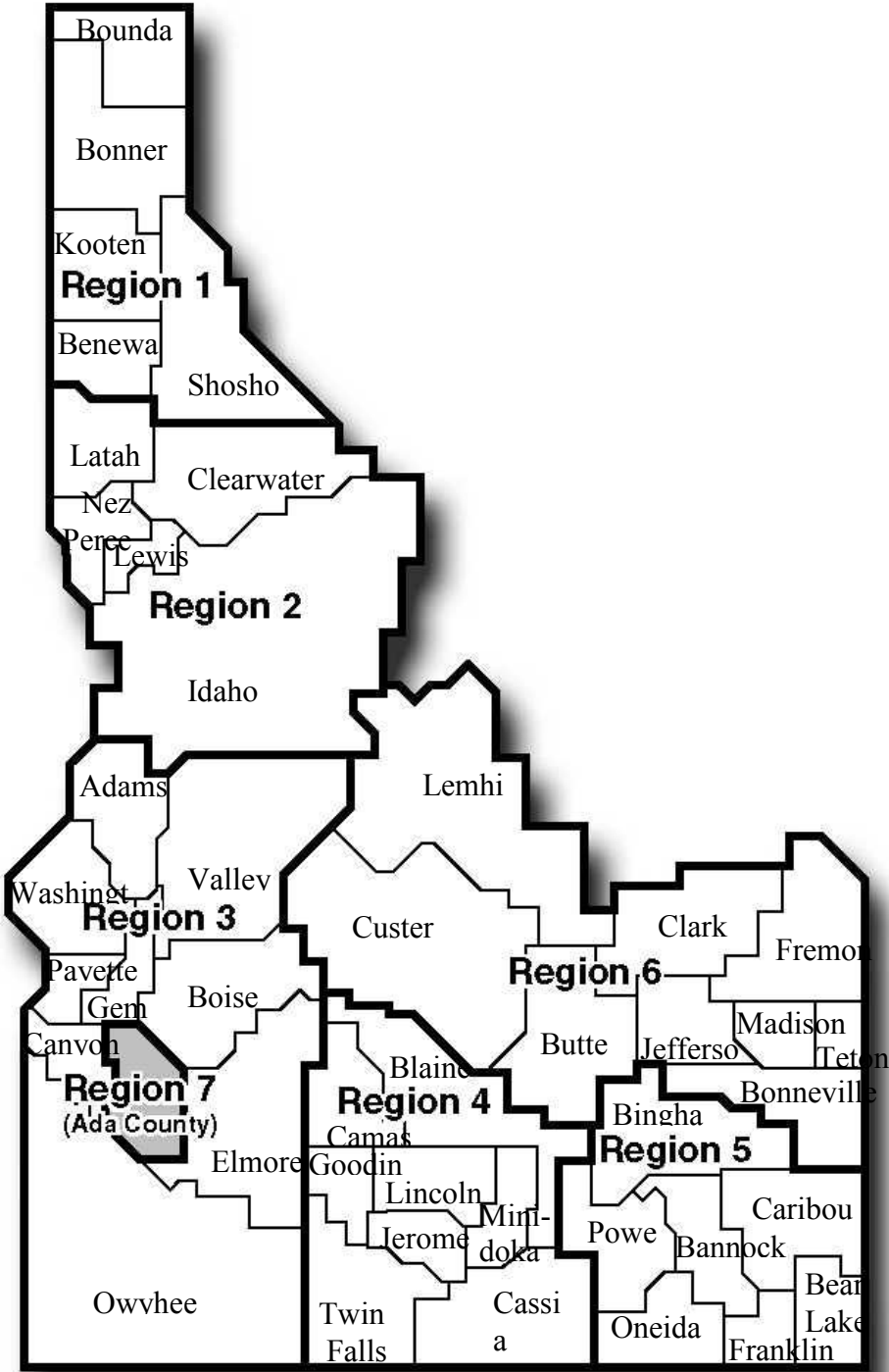
